Members are placed in the Ossining and Port Chester medical centers; Open Door has four types of positions available for the upcoming year:

- (1) **WELLNESS** – Enroll patients in exercise classes; lead the Recess Rocks! ® Nutrition Matters! and Cooking Matters Grocery Store Tour programs in our Wellness Centers as well as in the local community (schools, libraries, community centers, etc.)
- (2) **EXTERNAL RELATIONS-BABY BOX** – Member will make phone calls to patients to invite them to attend Baby Box Workshops; Make reminder phone calls; Make follow up phone calls to record program statistics; Help host Baby Box Workshops hosted in our health centers; Organization of Baby Box materials; Help with Baby Boxes assembly events; Manage reporting data including: Documenting patient phone calls in the electronic medical record; Making a monthly report on the Baby Box business user site
- (3) **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH** - plan and facilitate groups and outreach activities to promote healthy development in children and family wellness; work in cross-disciplinary teams to develop innovative program and marketing approaches that reinforce behavioral health, physical health, nutrition, wellness and literacy messages and deliver this outreach primarily in the waiting rooms.
- (4) **OUTREACH AND ENROLLMENT**- will expand the services of the Outreach and Enrollment department by following up with patients that are enrolled in a health insurance plan to see if they have any questions about its utilization and provide financial education regarding their plans. The member will expand the capacity of the existing department by assisting patients to enroll in health insurance in additional locations and hours. Members will also ensure that uninsured children at the School-based Health Centers are seen for eligibility through the NYS of Health Marketplace.

**Program Benefits:** The benefits include an annual stipend of **\$13,732**, education award upon successful completion of service, Health benefits, student loan forbearance, and professional development.

**Service Areas:** Children/Youth, Health, Education, Elder Care, Community and Economic Development, Community Outreach. Westchester County is a suburban area with relatively high living costs and limited public transportation. A car is highly recommended.
